- Increase the number of students in year 3 and 5 in the U2B for Mathematics to 50% by 2019

Funding a teacher to provide:


- Release time for staff for professional development around reading
- Using an inquiry cycle to continue to develop an explicit improvement agenda with a focus on reading
- Teacher observations and feedback around how reading is taught in classrooms

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Funding a teacher on day a week to release teachers from class to plan/observe/model reading lessons
- Working with cluster Head of Curriculum (HOC) to conduct inquiry cycle within our school
- Working with the Principal Advisor Teaching and Learning (PATaL) leader to implement the teaching reading series within our school
